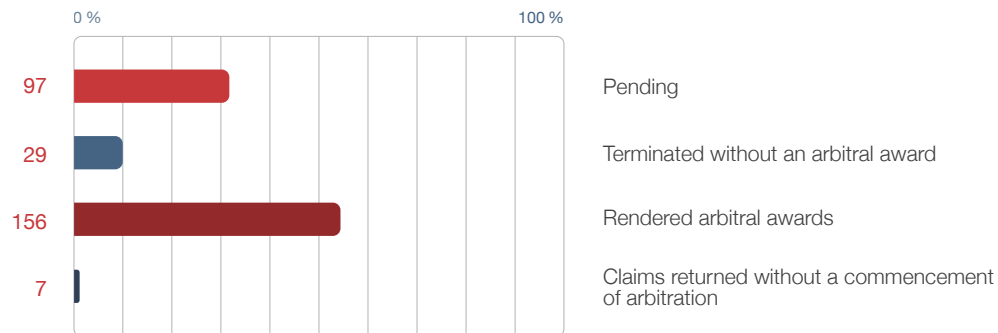

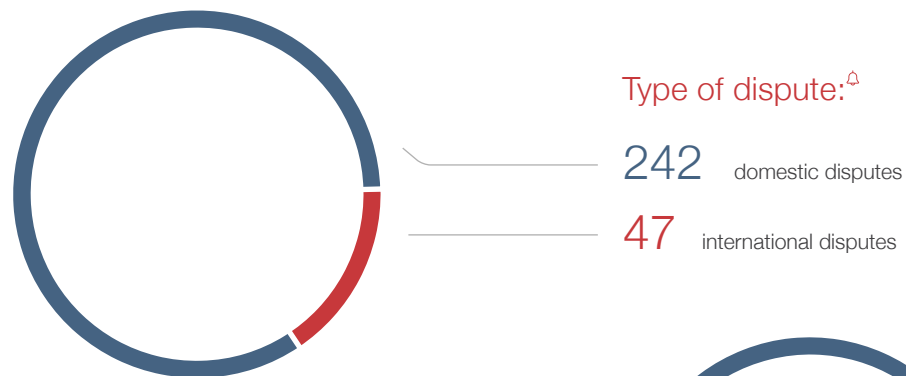
2022 Caseload Information

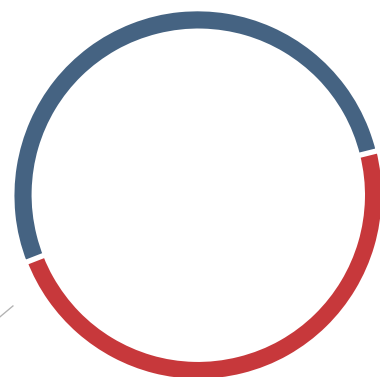

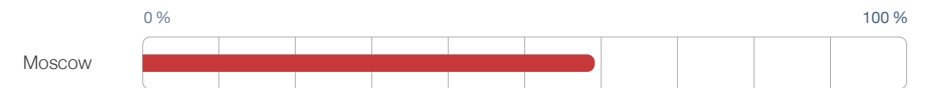

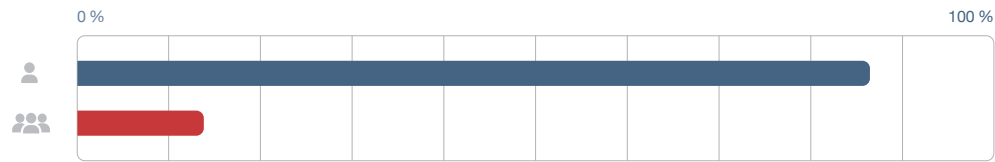

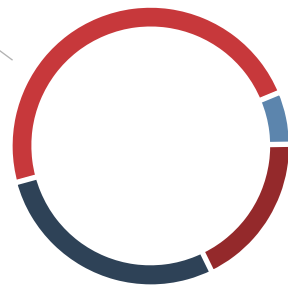

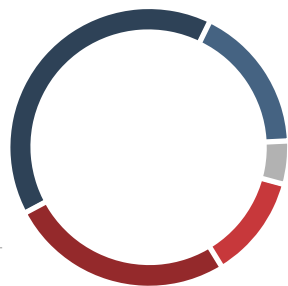

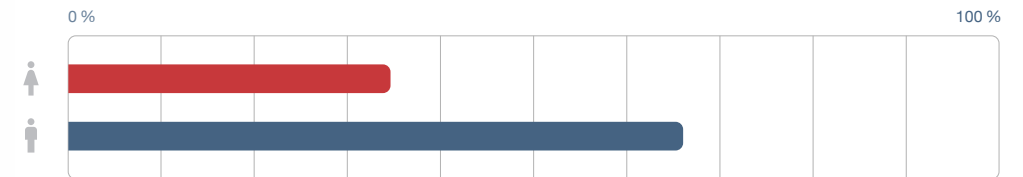

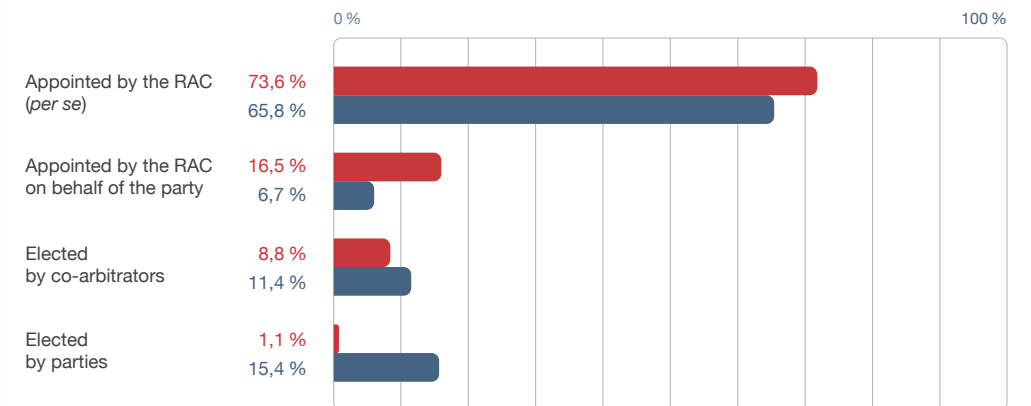


## PARTICIPATION OF MEN AND WOMEN AS ARBITRATORS

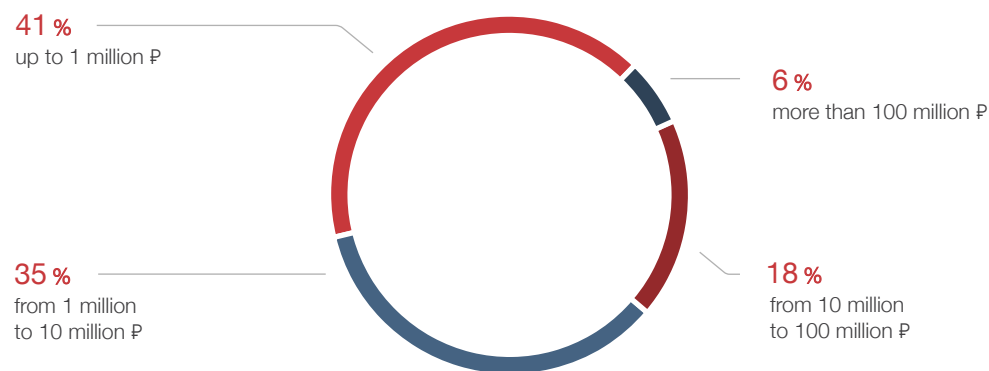

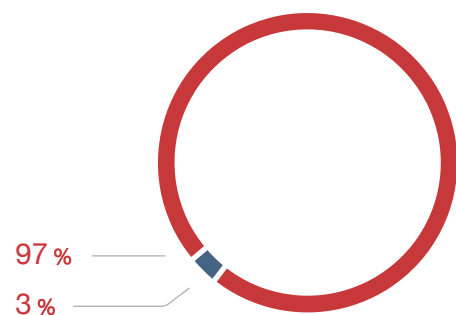

**100 %** enforceability of RAC's awards

Terminations of the proceedings were due to withdrawal of the applications, direct agreement of the parties on the finality of the arbitral award, the settlement agreement



The refusal to issue an enforcement order is related to voluntary compliance with the arbitral award

## Entire Arbitration Online

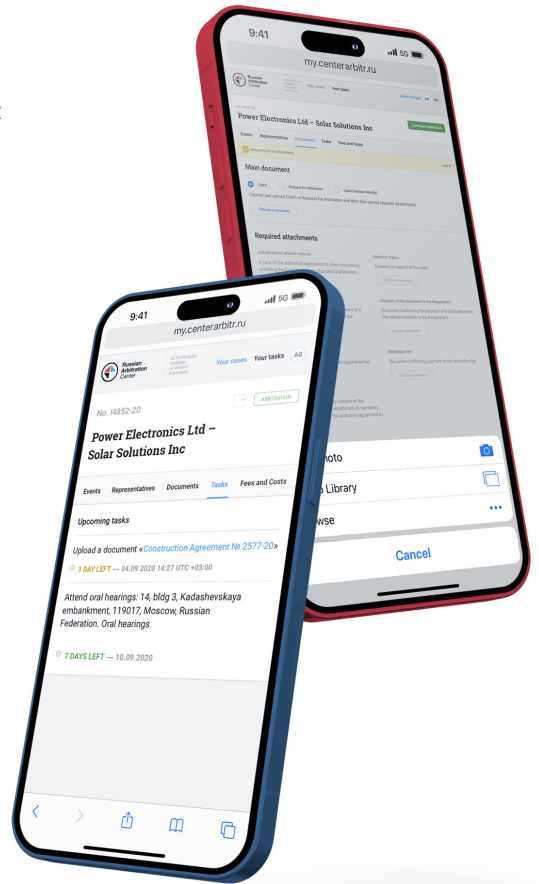
The whole process of arbitration from filing a claim to adoption of an arbitral award could be carried out through the Online System.
